Canada's Sports Hall of Fame

On October 28, 2008, the Board of Governors of Canada's Sports Hall of Fame announced that after an extensive bid and review process, Calgary, Alberta was selected as the new physical home for the CSHF. The CSHF's original home at Exhibition Place in Toronto was torn down to make way for a new soccer stadium. The cities of Toronto and Calgary were the two primary bidders. Calgary's bid originated with the Calgary Olympic Development Association and was supported by eight provincial and municipal organizations, plus the corporate sector. CSHF will be located in a new complex being built at Canada Olympic Park. COP, the site of the sliding sports and ski jumping for the 1988 Winter Olympic Games is near the Trans Canada highway, west of the City of Calgary. In the next few years prior to the physical facilities becoming available the CSHF Board and staff will continue its outreach program on the enhanced CSHF bilingual website.

As part of the continuing development of winter sport athletes and facilities, the Calgary Olympic Development Association (CODA) announced recently that it has rebranded itself in order to recognize more fully its national winter sports mandate. It is now known as WinSport Canada, the Winter Sport Institute.

Bob Duenkel, the Executive Director/Curator of the International Swimming Hall of Fame in Ft. Lauderdale, FL was the recipient of the prestigious Schroeder Award for Distinguished Service.

The 2009 ISHA conference is slated for Baltimore, Maryland, on October 27-29, 2009. This conference will be hosted by the Babe Ruth Birthplace and Museum/Sports Legends located at Camden Yards.

LIFE Photo Archive

Time, Inc. and Google have collaborated on a new photographic database called LIFE Photo Archive. This database contains millions of historical photographs, most of which were never published. Photo dates run from the 1750s to the 1970s. Searches can be done by decade or keyword. The same keyword subject approach may be used as that of <http://images.google.com/>. A special command can be used to access this particular database. For example one must add: *source:life* if this database is required when using the Images.google.com.

A search under *Olympics 1972 source:life* found a photo of Frank Shorter who won the marathon race at the Munich Olympics. By clicking on *purchase image merchandise*, one finds that an 8x11 photo costs \$79.96
