1.0 News from Sports Organizations

LA 84 Foundation and Digitization Projects

http://www.la84foundation.org/

In NASLINE no.29, February 2007, there appeared a short description of two sessions that were held at the 2006 ISHA/NASLIN conference. The topic of the session focused on the work undertaken to digitize *The Sporting Life*, a weekly periodical published from 1883-1917, 1922-1924.

It was also indicated that very few copies exist of this fragile, newsprint periodical. The National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum has arranged that their copy should be used for the LA84 Foundation project. Bindings of the bound backruns were cut so that each page can be gently slid onto a flatbed scanner for processing. The goal of the project is to produce the best-enhanced copy possible that has good optical character recognition. The major challenges included the fact that newsprint discoloration affects legibility and the small font size meant a high-resolution capture must be used, thus creating a large file size. The outcome was to have each page no bigger than one MB. Michael Kennedy, Imaging Technology Consultant, and Michael Holobek, President, of Annapolis Technologies, LLC, Baltimore, Maryland (http://www.annapolistech.com/) have undertaken the research necessary to achieve the high quality image definition goals.

Dr. Wayne Wilson of the LA84 Foundation announced that a number of digitized volumes of *The Sporting Life* will be available on the Foundation's website in March. This periodical will add greatly to the sport history research materials already on the LA84 Foundation website.

This website describes the large collection of video tapes held by CBC Archives. Five vaults contain 69,000 tapes with two vaults devoted to hockey games and interviews. All of the tapes are shot-listed, the information catalogued in the department's computer database for quick and easy access. The Sports archives add about 1,000 hours of new tape. In Winter Olympic years that number jumps to 2,000 hours while the Summer Olympic years, increases are closer to 3,000 hours.
