In Spring, SIRC Sport Research and EBSCO announced the availability of a fulltext version of SPORTDiscus. The SPORTDiscus database now has over 750,000 records in over 60 languages. It covers all aspects of sport and the sport sciences in the periodical literature, books, book chapters, theses, AV—that is, in just about every format.

International Association for Sports Information (IASI)

At the IASI annual meeting in Brasilia, Brazil, April 25-27, 2006, the philosophy of membership was changed and enhanced for this international group of sport information professionals and librarians who make up IASI membership. Up to this point all IASI services and publications have been available to anyone using the IASI website or the listserv. In keeping with other professional organizations, a Members Only section of the website will be created (and should be available in October). Only IASI members will participate in the IASI listserv (now called IASILIST), view the Membership List and have access to “trial” online journals, databases or other selected fulltext sport sciences materials.

The IASI website will also be updated to include a secure module so that membership application forms can be filled in online and payments made by credit card.

For Institutional Memberships not only the key contact person or official representative be added to IASILIST, but also that up to 5 additional persons/employees/members of that institution/association be given access to the listserv. In this way an institutional member may involve other key persons in IASI affairs and operations.

We invite North American institutions, departments and interested sport information professionals and librarians to join IASI. For IASI listserv participants who are not members may join IASI if, prior to October 31, 2006, membership payment is received. IASI offers 2006 and a 2007 membership (\$50 personal, \$75 Institutional) as a one-time-only offer.

2.2 Online Publishers, Publications and Documents

AIS Sports Science/Medicine Publications Database

A recent note from Greg Blood, Client Services Librarian at the Australian Sport Commission's National Sport Information Centre, announced the availability of the AIS Sport Science/Medicine Publications Database.

In cooperation with the AIS Applied Research Centre, this database of over 2000 research papers, applied sport articles and conference papers listed in the database at: <http://www.ais.org/au/research/rpphome.asp>

NSIC's Document Supply Service can provide photocopies or interlibrary loans for the publications listed. Note, however, that some unpublished conference papers may not be available.

Sport Content in Ebrary

In Canada, through the Canadian National Site Licensing Project (CNSLP) and the Canadian Research Knowledge Network (<http://www.cnslp.ca/>) additional online books and periodical issues are available. CNSLP started in 2000 with a \$20 million federal grant. With the joint buying and subscription power all 64 academic institutions in Canada each institution has access to many databases, e-book and e-periodical collections. Ebrary recently became available (<http://www.ebrary.com/>) with access to over 30,000 books, 1997 to date, from the major academic publishers, e.g. Routledge, McGraw Hill, BMJ Pubs, Falmer, Taylor & Francis and a large number of university presses. A university or college enquirer can search for a word in the text (over 10,000 hits for *sports*), or title (64 titles for subject heading *sports*). Ebrary has a customer base of over 900 institutions in 100 different countries. While access is rather pricey, nevertheless, this is an invaluable resource for sport and other researchers.
