1.2 SIRC (Sport Information Resource Centre)

This year, 2003 will be an important year for SIRC as it marks the 30th anniversary of the founding of the Sport Information Resource Centre. Stay tuned for celebrations later in the year.

As mentioned in previous issues of NASLINE, Linda Wheeler, Director of Product Development, has been working on a record enhancement/amalgamation project since 2002. As new cataloguing tapes are received from the Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles, Olympic Museum Library and HERACLES, duplicate records are merged and/or enhanced. In late 2002 SPORTDiscus was reloaded on the OVID platform to improve the functionality of this vendor's application. EbscoHost and Silverplatter have seen many "change records" in addition to the new material indexed each month. SPORTDiscus users will begin to notice enhancements such as French-language title translations, additional French-language abstracts and French-language descriptors when an English record is incorporated with HERACLES records.

New Serials Now Indexed for SPORTDiscus

The subjects and sources indexed for SPORTDiscus is ever growing in scope and coverage. Indexing in the area of tourism and hospitality has been expanded with the addition of indexing from the refereed journal,

In addition, Wish Publishing publications, are now being added and fully indexed for SPORTDiscus. 1.3 Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles (AAFLA)

In each issue of NASLINE we have reported on the continuing efforts of AAFLA to increase the number and scope of digitized publications available on the Virtual Library part of their website. Wayne Wilson, VP Research and Library Director mentioned that this section of their website is very popular having had 1.25 million PDF downloads from their Virtual Library website during 2002.

Two additional serials have been noticed on the AAFLA website. They are:

- Outing Magazine, 1888-1889
This project is in cooperation with the Minneapolis Public Library and it is intended that a modest run of this journal be made available, 1883-1915 in the near future.
- Baseball Magazine, (Official organ of the Baseball Players Fraternity)
v12, no. 4 Feb 1914 – to v16, no.6, April 1916
This short run is available on the AAFLA website now. As resources become available the entire run will be digitized.

AAFLA has just received permission to digitize the Barcelona Official Report (1982). This will be a welcomed addition to the Official Reports already available.

1.4 Other News Bytes

Sport Sciences Databases

The SPOLIT database produced by the Bundesinstitut für Sportwissenschaft is no longer available via DIMDI, the German medical/scientific database vendor system. SPOLIT, a database of over 135,000, mainly German language sport sciences records, is now available on the BISp website in Bonn, Germany at (http://www.bisp.de/Produkte/datenbank_neu/hilfe_cd.htm). In addition, the two other databases, SPOFOR (research reports) and SPOMEDIA (audiovisual material) are searchable at this website.

The South African Sports Commission/SISA database **Sportlit** is temporarily not available to the public via the internet. A colleague in South Africa reports that the database is still being updated inhouse. When the new computer system is installed, the database will be available once again via the web.

Kinesiology Publications (KinPubs) is the new name for the Microform Publications of Human Movement Studies, published by the International Institute for Sport and Human Performance at the University of Oregon. Henriette Heiny, IISHP Director also reports a change of name to their Microform Publications' Bulletin that will now be known as Kinesiology Abstracts (KinAbs). These new names reflect the subject matter of the theses and dissertations collection that are available to subscribers in microfiche format. This collection has been available since 1949, and covers all aspects of sport sciences and physical education. Each semi-annual set of 120 theses/dissertations sent to subscribing libraries are also indexed for and incorporated into SIRC's SPORTDiscus database. Individual researchers may also purchase single theses via the IISHP website as above.
