# 1.0 News from Sports Organizations

## 1.1 NASLIN

**8<sup>th</sup> NASLIN Conference, Nike Campus, Beaverton, Oregon,

The plans for the forthcoming NASLIN conference are well underway. The Planning Committee, local host Cindy Romaine, Librarian at Nike, Henriette Heiny, Director, Microform Publications of Human Movement Studies (U Oregon) and your editor are delighted to announce that the keynote speaker will be Diana Nyad. Diana joined FOX Sports Net in 1998 as the Senior Correspondent. She is well known for her long distance swimming successes and her flourishing career in sports media, especially the reports produced for the program Goin' Deep.

Other sessions planned include Digital Sport Group Roundtable, with Wayne Wilson, Dave Kelly and Ted Hathaway where discussions will be held on the work of the Digital Sport Group and other digitization plans and projects. Matt Naumann from Blackwell's North America in Lake Oswego will come to talk about online acquisition systems. Other sessions will include: the OP sports book market and technology in sports research. Exciting social activities are planned with a Friday evening dinner on the Nike Terrace overlooking the lake and topped off with a talk from Nike's motivating "catalyst", Kevin Carroll. For Saturday evening, a wine tour and dinner at the Ponzi Winery will cap off the 2 day conference.

### **Digital Sport Group (DSG)**

A small group has been formed in the past few months consisting of interested librarians and archivists who wish to pursue the digitization of 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> century US sports periodicals. This initiative began with a letter of proposal from Ted Hathaway, The Baseball Index Project Director, Society for American Baseball Research (and also INFORM Librarian at the Minneapolis Public Library). In this letter a number of periodical titles were proposed along with suggestions for funding. In the ensuing months emails flew back and forth and your editor compiled a seven-page list of titles with publishing, format and indexing information. Wayne Wilson, VP and Library Director of the Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles, offered to conduct an experiment with the three types of digitization and also pledged AAFLA support to digitize a ten-year run of a title. Upon Ted's suggestion, the DSG agreed that the magazine *Outing* should be our first focus. This journal, especially in the latter part of the 19<sup>th</sup> century had a wide range of recreation, leisure and sport articles.

After testing various methods of producing a digital version of Outing, we have decided to convert to PDF Normal rather than using a lesser version of PDF. This will allow keyword searching of the text. We also have chosen to photocopy the original documents before delivering them to the conversion service. This will significantly reduce the handling charge, for the company has to be especially careful with older, fragile materials. The qualitative difference in digital copies from photocopies was very small when compared to the digital version from the original print.

## HELP NEEDED

For the next phase, DSG is seeking a library that holds an unbound copy of Outing and/or librarians (or their staff) who would be willing to see to photocopying of the issues in at least one volume in the date range from 1888 to 1897. Or if some libraries have a bound volume where the issues still have covers this would be suitable. If the library system has a "top down" photocopier then the photocopies would be of high quality. The planned release date for the update is the end of March 2001. ### **Indexing news**

In an effort to increase coverage in the SPORTDiscus, it has been decided that chapters within books (book analytics) can be indexed in the case of books written by a single author. In the past, the practice was to select and index only individual chapters included in a manual directed by one or several editors. This change in indexing policy is explained in the "Book Analytics" section of the Indexing Manual that is available to those interested. A further decision has been made to increase the coverage of basic level physical education journals. This will enhance the content of the SPORTDiscus in this major area of interest to a specific market of users.

### **Marketing**

## **1.3 Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles (AAFLA)**

### **National Track & Field Hall of Fame Research Collection (NTFHFR)**

In December 2000, it was announced that AAFLA would acquire the National Track & Field Hall of Fame Research Collection according to an agreement reached by AAFLA and the USA Track & Field association. The collection includes thousands of books, manuscripts, periodicals and other materials that chronicle the history of track and field and American track and field athletes. It will become part of AAFLA's outstanding sports library that currently holds 35,000 print volumes, 90,000 photo images, 8,000 microform volumes and 6,000 videos. AAFLA plans to convert selected resources of the collection from paper to digital format to include them with the substantive sport history digital collection already available on the AAFLA website (<http://www.aafla.org/>). The collection's catalogue will also be available on AAFLA's website.

The NTFHFR opened in 1986 at the Butler University Library in Indianapolis, where it is currently located. Due to space limitations, Butler is unable to continue to house the collection. USATF earlier this year solicited bids from cities around the country interest in housing the collection.

We will keep NASLINE readers posted as to the when the collection may be accessed online.

## 1.4 Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame (NBHF)

Doug Stark, Librarian/Archivist at the NBHF reports that a new exhibit has just opened entitled "Freedom to Play: the Life and Times of Basketball's African-American Pioneers. The exhibit documents the contributions of African-Americans to basketball from 1900 to the 1960s on the barnstorming, college and professional levels for both men and women. See the NBHF website for further information. The exhibit runs from February 1 to May 15, 2001. From March to June 31, 2001 a photographic show will open featuring Dick Raphael, the legendary photographer of the Boston Celtics.

The NBHF Library continues to make progress in organizing and making accessible the collection. In November 1999, the NBHF received a donation from John McCue one of the largest private collectors of basketball cards in the US. The Museum recently completed the first in a series of shows highlighting McCue's collection that dates from the early 1900s to 1993. The first display showcased cards from 1911 to 1961. The collection is presently being processed.

The Library also just completed a major film transfer project. With the assistance of VidiPax, the largest and most advanced magnetic media restoration company, the library is transferring over 400, 16mm reels of film. The work involves over 500 hours of film spanning more than 50 years of basketball history. The film footage includes college films from the 1950s, Converse highlights, professional game footage, interviews, Hall of Fame enshrinement ceremonies and instructional films. The film will be incorporated into the Hall's Library, made available for researchers and staff and will be shown as a film series in the Converse Theater at the NBHF.

ASU is an especially appropriate home for such a collection as it is located in the Blue Ridge Mountains, the home of the bootleggers whose driving skills gave birth to the sport of stock car racing. ### 2.2 Scholarly Websites

#### Information Hubs in the UK BIOME (Health and Life Sciences)

The BIOME information hub or gateway contains links to evaluated, quality Internet resources in the health and life sciences, selected and annotated for students, researchers, academics and practitioners. The core BIOME team is based at the University of Nottingham, Greenfield Medical Library and is in partnership with key health and life sciences organizations throughout the UK. Funded by the Joint Information Systems Committee <http://www.jisc.ac.uk/>, it is part of the Resource Discovery Network <http://www.rdn.ac.uk/> (JISC is a strategic advisory committee working on behalf of the funding bodies for higher and further education, e.g. Scottish Higher Education Funding Council)

The BIOME website has a number of introductory sections that list and describe the criteria for selection of a quality website for this hub. The site has a basic and advanced level search engine plus a browse feature for the five major subject divisions e.g. Onmi the health and medicine section.

Other hubs have also been established recently including the SOSIG website for the Social Sciences <http://www.sosig.ac.uk/>. In a recent search of this website it was discovered that there is some sport-related content.

#### Upgraded Sections on Scholarly Sport Sites (SSS)

In the Database/Directories – Biography section of SSS, additional resources have been found while using the meta-search engine, Google <http://www.google.com/>. Added to this section are the following:

Current Biography Excerpts – The well-known publisher of library reference tools, H.W. Wilson has produced excerpts from many sports biographies that have appeared in issues of Current Biography from 1983 to date.

Hickok Sports.com – This website, produced by Ralph Hickok, an author of many biographical dictionaries, has the beginnings of the over 3,000 biographies he has written. On his website the researcher can find biographies for sports figures with surnames A to F. Ralph has a long way to go to get to the Z surnames, but this website is continually updated.

Women's Sports Legends Online – Tennis sports legend Billie Jean King and a number of her retired colleagues have created a website to promote the Sports Legends Speakers Bureau of women athletes (and a few men) from many sports. See this website for biographical information on each speaker.

Coaches' Info Service – This website, which can be found in the Databases/Directories – Coaching section on SSS, is sponsored by ISBS (International Society for Biomechanics in Sports). There are 12 sections on biomechanical applications in specific sports, e.g. basketball, gymnastics, soccer, swimming, where academic researchers have produced fulltext and statistical information related to specific sports. Additional topics coming soon to this website include: strength & conditioning, becoming a better coach and injury prevention.

In the Libraries/Information Centers – Europe section of SSS the link to the British Library (BL) has been changed. The UK's national library, BL has just made available its Public Catalogue (BLPC) of over 10 million records. Included also are the conference proceedings records (1800s +) from the Document Supply Centre. While this is not the entire holdings of this distinguished library, nevertheless most of the books & reports are from the 1970s (Serials from 1700s +). A quick search the other day for the subject, figure skating found some early 1900s imprints. Do take some time reading the home pages of BL for they contain good descriptions of their vast holdings.

## **2.3 Online Publishers, Publications and Documents**

Sports consulting companies, especially those in the sports media and sports administration and business areas are making their presence and products known on the web. Most publish pricey newsletters and reports on topics of current interest.
